

MILTON BOROUGH COUNCIL MEETING

July 28, 2010

The meeting was called to order with the following Councilpersons in attendance: Mr. Budman, Mr. Barr, President Reedy, Mrs. Meckley, Mrs. Ulmer, Mr. Davis, Mr. Swartz, Mr. Shearer, Mr. Specht, and Mr. Farr. Also in attendance were Chuck Beck, Shelly Wood, Attorney Benion, and Chief Lutcher. Mayor Nelson was absent.

Minutes: On motion of Mr. Budman, seconded by Mr. Barr, and carried, Council approved the minutes from the July 14, 2010 Council meeting.

Report of the Borough Manager: Mr. Beck reported that the parking lot is 90% completed. The only thing left to do is the landscaping and seal the curblin on the outside perimeter of the curb. He asked Council's decision on parking restrictions. President Reedy tabled this to the Highway Committee. Parking in the parking lot shall be permit-parking only between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. On motion of Mr. Shearer, seconded by Mr. Swartz and carried Council authorized Mayor Nelson to temporarily impose parking restrictions to read – no parking from 11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m., and limit parking to two hours between 6:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. in the diagonal parking on the west side of Bound Avenue and east side of Elm Street from Broadway to Center.

Report of the Mayor: Mayor Nelson was absent.

Report of the President of Council: President Reedy had no report.

Public Comments: There were no public comments.

Highways and Protection to Persons and Property

- A. On motion of Mrs. Ulmer, seconded by Mr. Shearer, Council denied a grievance from Robert Graham.

Mr. Beck informed Council that this is the last grievance they will receive from Mr. Graham. The next step may be a binding arbitration hearing.

Mrs. Ulmer reported that the Highway Committee met tonight and went over the guidelines for Borough-owned vehicles. Attorney Benion will review these suggestions and bring them back to Council for approval.

General Government and Recreation

- A. On motion of Mr. Barr, seconded by Mr. Davis and carried, Council approved a request for a subdivision in the 5th ward.
- B. On motion of Mr. Barr, seconded by Mr. Davis and carried Council adopted Ordinance 1171 to vacate a portion of Follmer Avenue.

Finance, Health, and Sanitation

- A. On motion of Mr. Budman, seconded by Mr. Farr, and carried, Council approved paying the bills from General Fund, Investment Reserve, Payroll, Pool, Liquid Fuels, and Cemetery accounts in the amount of \$85,851.34.

There being no further business, on motion of Mrs. Meckley, seconded by Mr. Budman and carried, Council adjourned at 7:23 p.m.
