

MILTON BOROUGH COUNCIL MEETING

July 8, 2009

The meeting was called to order with the following Councilpersons in attendance: Mr. Hartzel, Mr. Budman, Mr. Clemens, Mrs. Ulmer, Mrs. Meckley, Mr. Davis, and Mr. Shearer. Also in attendance were Chuck Beck, Shelly Wood, Attorney Benion, and Mayor Nelson. President Reedy, Mr. Ormsbee, and Mr. Johnson were absent.

Minutes: On motion of Mr. Hartzel, seconded by Mrs. Ulmer, and carried, Council approved the minutes from the June 24, 2009 Council meeting.

Report of the Borough Manager: Mr. Beck reported that there have been problems with the new recycling dumpsters. Although there has been a cost-savings to the Borough, people are putting the wrong things in the wrong dumpsters, particularly glass. Mr. Beck stated that if it continues, the dumpsters will have to be locked up and they will only be available when they can be monitored. If you throw the wrong piece of glass in the wrong dumpster, the entire dumpster has to be landfilled because it contaminates the entire load. Mrs. Ulmer asked if it would help if the signs were also in Spanish.

Next, Mr. Beck updated Council on Brown Avenue Park. The new pavilion is done, and there is now a water fountain at every pavilion. There is no electric at Kidstown or at the new pavilion because it has to go out for bid because it is over \$10,000. This should be ready to install around September of this year. The U.S. Fish and Wildlife is hoping to be completed with the riverbank project by this Friday.

Report of the Mayor: Mayor Nelson commended Mr. Beck and the Public Works crew on their work on the new pavilion.

Report of the President of Council: There was no report.

Public Comments: There were no public comments.

Highways and Protection to Persons and Property

- A. On motion of Mrs. Ulmer, seconded by Mr. Clemens and carried, Council approved a request from Cub Pack 3605 to hold their annual Cub Mobile Race on Saturday, September 12, 2009.
- B. On motion of Mrs. Ulmer, seconded by Mr. Clemens and carried, Council approved a request from the SWAT U14 softball team to hold a softball tournament at Brown Avenue Park on August 15th and 16th.

General Government and Recreation – No report.

Finance, Health, and Sanitation

- A. On motion of Mr. Budman, seconded by Mr. Hartzel, and carried, Council approved paying the General Fund, Payroll, Pool, Liquid Fuels, Reserve, and Cemetery accounts in the amount of \$172,177.10.

There being no further business, on motion of Mr. Hartzel, seconded by Mrs. Ulmer and carried, Council adjourned at 7:16 p.m.
