MILTON BOROUGH COUNCIL MEETING

October 28, 2015

The meeting was called to order with the following Councilpersons in attendance: Mr. Specht, Mr. Budman, Mr. Cyphers, Mrs. Meckley, Mr. Farr, Mr. Jones, Mr. Shearer, and Mr. Swartz. Also in attendance were Mr. Beck, Attorney Benion, and Shelly Sandstrom. Mr. Keiser, Mr. Walker, and Mayor Nelson were absent.

<u>Minutes:</u> On motion of Mr. Cyphers, seconded by Mr. Swartz and carried, Council approved the minutes from the October 14, 2015 Council meeting.

Report of the Borough Manager: Mr. Beck reported that the Broadway phase of the 2017 Streetscape Project is complete. We are still waiting to hear about the next grant.

Next, Mr. Beck informed Council that he has begun the police negotiations. He has notified the Teamster's that we are prepared to begin negotiations but has not received a response.

Report of the Mayor: Mayor Nelson was absent

Report of the President of Council: President Budman had no report.

Report of the Chief of Police: Chief Zettlemoyer was absent.

Report of the Fire Chief: Fire Chief Shaffer was absent.

<u>Public Comments:</u> Tom Powell, Jr. of Powell's Broadway News addressed Council stating that a lot of people are complaining about the parking meters in front of their business as it is an in-and-out shop. He said that no meters are on the opposite side of the street. Mr. Beck responded the meters in front of the newsstand have been in place since the Borough's parking meter ordinance was enacted. The old meters were taken out during the 2017 Streetscape Project and replaced with new ones. President Budman stated that it would be a terrible idea to take the meters away as residents living in the downtown would use them, leaving no parking for their business. Mr. Powell suggested putting in 10-minute parking zones.
