Report of the Borough Manager: Mr. Beck reported that he received the 2017 904 Recycling Performance grant in the amount of \$24,895.00. This amount is an increase of \$600 from last year.

Report of the Mayor: Mayor Nelson informed council that he received a letter from New England Motor Freight stating that they will be doing layoffs in several locations including Milton. This will affect 60 people.

Report of the President of Council: President Budman had no report.

Report of Chief of Police: Chief Zettlemoyer reported the department had to use Naloxone this week with success. They are currently investigating a death that occurred over the weekend.

Report of Public Works Director: Sam Shaffer reported that the recent storm was uneventful. The department has been doing maintenance on the plows and equipment. They will be using cold patch to work on potholes throughout the Borough as weather permits.

Report of the Fire Chief: Joe Stump was not in attendance.

Public Comments: There were no public comments.
