MILTON BOROUGH COUNCIL MEETING

September 11, 2019

<u>Report of the Borough Manager</u>: Ms. Novinger had no report as she has been on maternity leave. Mr. Beck had no report.

Report of the Mayor: Mayor Nelson was absent.

<u>Report of the President of Council:</u> President Budman read a Resolution to be adopted by Council regarding the Multimodal Transportation Fund Grant for the Borough of Milton for the reconstruction of Marsh Road. On motion of Mrs. Meckley, seconded by Mr. Walker and carried, Council adopted Resolution #19-05 as outlined by President Budman.

<u>Report of Chief of Police</u>: Officer Gaugler reported that the Department will be at the Harvest Festival in the upcoming weeks. He also reported that the cruiser is now back in service.

<u>Report of Public Works Director:</u> Sam Shaffer reported that the Department has been paving alleys and the fifth ward is complete. They have started the renovations at Brown Avenue Park Project, which will provide 20 additional parking spaces in the Kidstown area. The community pool is closed and winterized. All leaks have been prepared. Street cleaning has been started and will continue for the Harvest Festival.
