- 1) CLEAR GLASS BOTTLES Must be rinsed out & clean. **NO LIDS**
- 2) BROWN GLASS BOTTLES Must be rinsed out & clean. **NO LIDS**
- 3) TIN & BI-METAL CANS Must be rinsed out & clean. Labels must be removed.
- 4) ALUMINUM CANS Must be rinsed out & clean.
- 5) MAGAZINES Tied in bundles, in paper bags or buckets **ONLY**
(No plastic bags or boxes)
- 6) NEWSPAPERS Tied in bundles, in paper bags or buckets **ONLY**
(No plastic bags or boxes)
