

MILTON BOROUGH COUNCIL
(Hybrid Meeting)

April 8, 2026
7:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order by President Walker. The following Councilpersons were in attendance: Ms. Morales, Mr. Swartz, Mr. Scheimreif, Ms. Fawess, Mr. Pfeil, Mr. Derr, and Mrs. Meckley, and Mr. Morales. Also attending were Mrs. Foust, Atty. Grimes, and Chief Zettlemoyer and Mayor Aber.

Minutes: On motion from Mr. Derr, seconded by Ms. Fawess and carried, Council approved the minutes from the March 25, 2026, Council Meeting.

Report of the Borough Manager: Chief Zettlemoyer reported the following to Council: Last Tuesday, he attended Senator Culver's First Responders Grant Seminar held in Danville. Presentations were given by Joe Marsicano, PA Senate Funding and Resource Specialist; Randy Padfield, PEMA Director; Tom Wellington, USDA Rural Development Area Director; and Thomas Cook, PA State Fire Commissioner. They provided information regarding grant funding opportunities for first responders.

Brian Auman has completed his in-person interviews and will present his findings to Council at an upcoming meeting. Based on my conversations with Brian, many excellent ideas were shared by community stakeholders.

The annual Spring Cleanup is scheduled for April 13–17 and will be completed by Ward. Details are posted on the Borough website and Facebook page. Residents are asked to separate brush and leaves into distinct piles. Plants must have roots and root balls removed prior to disposal. New-hire testing for the Police Department will be held next Tuesday. We anticipate having a certified list available at the next Council meeting.

At the next meeting, the Department of Public Works and Cemetery Committee will provide Council with an update regarding the adopted traffic ordinance and any proposed modifications.

Report of the Mayor: No Report

Report of the President of Council: President Walker advised that the fire department's annual banquet will be held on Saturday, April 11, 2026, from 5-8. He advised that a meeting will be held this week with all the parties that use the Brown Avenue Park fields to discuss care and usage of the field and the vision for the Park Master Site Plan. The Candidates for Borough Council will be at the next meeting scheduled for April 22, 2026.

Public Safety:

- Consideration to approve the Terms of Employment for Curt Zettlemyer for dual role as part-time Borough Manager and part-time Chief of Police.
 - On motion from Mr. Derr, seconded by Mr. Moralez, and carried, Council approved this request.

Mr. Lynn Yocum asked if there were any other candidates for this position? President Walker advised that there are several communities that have a position like this dual role. Mr. Pfeil advised that council approved on an interim basis back in January to have this position as a dual role and Curt has been handling both very well since then, and that is what led to today's motion.

General Government and Finance:

- Consideration to pay bills from the General Fund, Reserve, Payroll, Liquid Fuels, and Cemetery account in the amount of \$105,042.08.
 - On motion from Ms. Fawess, seconded by Mrs. Meckley, and carried, Council approved this request.

President Walker asked if there were any other questions from the public or Council, one resident advised she didn't have a question, but showed up to hear what was going to happen with the parking on Upper Market St. since social media had several posts about it.
