The Milton Borough Civil Service Commission is accepting applications for the creation of an Eligibility List with the Milton Borough Police Department. The list will be utilized to fill fulltime vacancies.

Requirements:

- U.S. Citizen – Minimum 21 years of age by the date of written examination
- Must have or be eligible to obtain Act 120 Certification prior to the date of appointment
- Be physically and mentally fit to perform the full duties of a police officer
- Possess a valid motor vehicle driver's license prior to appointment and possess no suspensions on said license for a period of ten (10) years prior to the date of application
- Possess a diploma from a high school accredited by an educational accrediting agency recognized by the United States Department of Education, or possess a graduate equivalency diploma
- Successfully pass written and oral examinations, and physical agility test. Upon a vacancy, candidates on the eligibility list will need to pass a background and polygraph examinations along with medical and psychological examinations
