

MILTON BOROUGH COUNCIL
(Hybrid Meeting)

March 11, 2026
7:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order by President Walker. The following Councilpersons were in attendance: Ms. Morales, Mrs. Mabus, Mr. Swartz, Mr. Morales, Ms. Fawess, Mr. Pfeil, Mr. Derr. Also attending were Mrs. Foust, Atty. Grimes, Chief Zettlemoyer and Mayor Aber. Absent from the meeting were Mr. Scheimreif and Mrs. Meckley.

At this time 7:01 pm, Council entered an executive session to discuss legal and personnel matters. The Executive session ended at 7:13 pm.

Minutes: On motion from Mr. Pfeil, seconded by Mr. Morales and carried, Council approved the minutes from the February 25, 2026, Council Meeting.

Report of the Borough Manager: Chief Zettlemoyer reported the following to Council:
A meeting is scheduled for Friday morning regarding the Comcast Franchise Agreement and installation process. A list of documented violations will be presented to Comcast representatives. Attorney Wiley has made strong progress toward finalizing the agreement, and we expect to have a signed document before the next meeting.
Kaylei has been assigned to research options and develop a plan for updating the Borough website. This project will include online training on social media management and implementing a single-source posting process across multiple platforms.
The Borough crew continues installing signage required to comply with the recently enacted traffic ordinance.
The initial Recycling Grant submission has been provided to county officials for review. A meeting with the General Government Committee will be scheduled to review the ordinance governing the recycling reporting process.
The annual Spring Cleanup is scheduled for April 13–17 and will be completed by Ward. Details will be posted on the Borough website and Facebook page. Residents are asked to separate brush and leaves into distinct piles. Plants must have roots and root balls removed prior to disposal.
Bryan Auman continues to schedule meetings with stakeholders to discuss the Brown Ave. Park Master Site Plan.
The camera project is progressing. Infrastructure has been installed at the Elementary School and High School, and cameras in the park are expected to come online by the next council meeting.

Report of the Mayor: The mayor questioned if there is a swearing in? Chief Zettlemoyer advised for the Chief only.

Report of the President of Council: President Walker advised that Little League season has begun please be safe and stop out to encourage them. We send all our thoughts to the PSP for the officer that was killed. We stand with all first responders and wish them safety every time they go out.
