

## ORDINANCE NO. 1268

### **AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON, NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1263, AS AMENDED, CHAPTER 233, TRAFFIC, TO REVISE CERTAIN TRAFFIC CONTROL, PARKING, AND VEHICLE REGULATIONS WITHIN THE BOROUGH.**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council of the Borough of Milton has determined that revisions to the Borough's traffic and parking regulations are necessary for the protection of the public health, safety, and welfare; and

**WHEREAS**, Borough Council desires to amend Ordinance No. 1263, as amended, Chapter 233, Traffic, to modify designated one-way streets, stop-controlled intersections, parking restrictions, special purpose parking, and restrictions on oversized vehicles.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by the Council of the Borough of Milton, Northumberland County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

#### **Section 1. Amendment to §233-51 One-Way Streets.**

The provisions of Ordinance No. 1263 relating to designated one-way streets are hereby amended by removing the one-way designation for Fairview Avenue between Stills Hill Road and Brown Avenue. Upon the effective date of this Ordinance, Fairview Avenue between Stills Hill Road and Brown Avenue shall no longer be designated as a one-way street.

#### **Section 2. Amendment to §233-53 – Stop Sign Intersections.**

Section 233-53, "Stop Sign Intersections," is amended as follows:

A. The stop signs controlling traffic on Poplar Avenue at Upper Market St. are hereby removed.

#### **Section 3. Amendment to §233-58 – Parking Prohibited at All Times.**

Section 233-58, "Parking Prohibited at All Times," is amended as follows:

A. Add the following:

Turbot Avenue – East Side: From Hepburn Street north to Schoolhouse Lane, parking is prohibited at all times.

B. Amend the regulations applicable to Park Avenue to provide that parking shall be permitted on the south side only.

#### **Section 4. Amendment to §233-62 – Special Purpose Parking.**

Section 233-62 is amended by adding the following designated handicap parking spaces:

##### **A. Second Street – South Side**

Beginning at the southeast curb face of Lincoln Street; thence following the south curblineline of Second Street west a distance of thirty (30) feet; thence continuing west an additional twenty (20) feet, which twenty-foot space is designated as reserved handicap parking for the residence located at 502 Lincoln Street.

**B. Upper Market Street – South Side**

Beginning at the southeast curb face of Tuckey Alley; thence following the south curbline of Upper Market Street west a distance of thirty (30) feet; thence continuing west an additional twenty (20) feet, which twenty-foot space is designated as reserved handicap parking for the residence located at 214 Upper Market Street.

**C. Park Ave – South Side**

In Front of 225 Park Avenue

**Section 5. Amendment to §233-55(B) – Vehicles in Excess of Forty-Five (45) Feet in Length.**

Section 233-55(B) is amended by deleting the restriction applicable to Marsh Road at the intersection of Housels Run and Marsh Road, thereby removing that location from the list of restrictions applicable to vehicles in excess of forty-five (45) feet in length.

**Section 6. Repealer.**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**Section 7. Severability.**

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

**Section 8. Effective Date.**

This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after enactment, or as otherwise provided by law.
